

Concord College Boarding

FEES

Boarding fees for the academic year 2020/21 will be £15,000 per term (£45,000 per annum). Fees are due for payment on a half yearly basis and invoices are issued accordingly, clearly stating the due date.

For Day fees please refer to Day Student Admissions section.

Fees are payable on a twice yearly basis in advance. Initial invoices are issued three months prior to the commencement of the course and subsequent invoices are issued each December and June. Once the offer of a place has been made, a deposit must be sent to the College to reserve this place. Deposits vary depending on the status of the child and details can be obtained from the Admissions Secretary. Deposits will be retained by the College and credited without interest to the final account when the child leaves the school. They are normally non-refundable if the student withdraws having held a place that could have been given to another student.

What is Included?

- Tuition
- Accommodation
- Students* have the privilege to stay in College during the Easter holiday **for which a charge will be made from September 2019**.**
- Use of all College facilities
- Access to all College clubs and societies (except horse riding)
- Meals
- Laundry
- Regular visits to Shrewsbury and elsewhere

** Students in Forms 3 & 4 are not permitted to stay at Easter. Students in Form 5 may be given permission to stay by the Head of Lower School.*
